





STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All orders received and sales made by Husky Injection Molding Systems Ltd. or its affiliates (collectively referred to as "Husky") are expressly conditioned on Buyer's acceptance of these terms and conditions and Husky's quotation. Husky rejects any additional or conflicting terms previously or hereafter proposed by Buyer unless expressly agreed to in writing by Husky. Acceptance by Buyer of any product will constitute acceptance of these terms and conditions.

1. Timely Performance

Husky will use all reasonable efforts to complete the manufacturing of the equipment described in the quotation within the timeframe estimated. Any changes to the Buyer's order by Buyer, Buyer's representatives, advisors or agents may affect Husky's timely performance.

2. Price and Terms of Payment

The purchase price in Husky's quotation does not include taxes, duties, shipping, installation or any other fee or expense of any kind, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by Husky. In addition to such purchase price, Buyer agrees to pay Husky the amount of all governmental taxes, excises and/or other charges that Buyer may be required to pay with respect to the sale and transportation of any product delivered hereunder.

3. Delivery

Unless otherwise stated in writing by Husky, product shall be shipped ex-works from Husky's or Supplier's facility, where applicable. Buyer agrees to bear the exclusive risk of loss or damage to the product at all times after supplier has turned the product over to the carrier for shipment. Husky will not insure shipments. If a delivery date is specified by Buyer, Husky will use commercially reasonable efforts to deliver the product to a carrier for shipment by the specified date, but Husky will have no liability for delays after the product has been delivered to a carrier. Husky will have no liability for delays or failure to perform any obligations if such delay or failure to perform results from a cause beyond Husky's reasonable control, including, without limitation, power interruption, war, fire, flood, natural disaster, strike or other labor dispute, civil unrest, act of government authority, act of God, failure or delay of transportation or supply or raw materials shortage.

4. Interruption Charge

If the order is placed on hold, canceled or if machine or mold design changes are requested after commencement of engineering and/or manufacturing, the Buyer will be responsible for an interruption charge on all or part of the order to cover such other additional expenses relating to production rescheduling, additional set-ups, handling, storage, inventory costs, obsolescence etc.

5. Relocation

Husky must be contacted prior to Husky equipment being relocated from its original installation in order to review applicable safety regulations and services (i.e. electrical voltage, frequency), operating environment (i.e. temperature/humidity), and to make such additional equipment modifications as may be required to operate equipment safely, and optimize equipment service. If the Buyer performs such relocation without Husky's assistance, as described above, the Buyer does so at its own risk.

6. Limited Warranty

Except as set forth in Husky's written warranty provided by Husky to Buyer, Husky makes no additional warranties, whether express, implied or statutory. Husky specifically disclaims any warranty for merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

7. Confidentiality

Buyer and Husky agree to take reasonable steps to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary or confidential information of the other within each of their respective organizations. Husky will, at Buyer's request, transmit information to Buyer by e-mail, over the Internet. Should any confidentiality breach(es) occur because of data transmission over the Internet pursuant to Buyer's request, Buyer agrees that this will not constitute a breach of any obligation of confidentiality owed to Buyer by Husky. If Buyer wish to limit such transmission to information that is not highly confidential, or seek more secure means of communication for highly confidential information, Buyer should inform Husky accordingly.

8. Indemnification

Buyer agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Husky, its affiliates, and respective officers, directors, employees and agents, from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including legal fees and expenses, arising out of or in any way connected with this Agreement, including, but not limited to, any act or omission by Buyer, infringement of any intellectual property rights of third parties due to Husky's satisfaction of Buyer's requirements, or injury to Buyer's employees.

9. Limitations on Liability

Under no circumstances will Husky be responsible for indirect, consequential, incidental, special, collateral, punitive or exemplary damages, including without limitation, loss of goodwill, loss of profits or revenues. Any and all legal actions and claims by Buyer against Husky, shall be barred unless written notice thereof is received by Husky within 180 days of the date of the event giving rise to such action or claim.

10. Governing Law and Jurisdiction of Courts

This Agreement shall be governed and construed according to the laws of [Ontario, Illinois, Luxembourg], and the Courts of [Ontario, Illinois, Luxembourg] shall have exclusive jurisdiction to resolve any disputes. The U.N. Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods shall not be applicable to this Agreement or related transactions.

11. Complete Agreement

This Agreement sets out the final terms and conditions of our understanding and supersedes any previous understanding, agreements or representations whether made orally or in writing, unless Husky and Buyer execute an Equipment Sale and Security Agreement or an Equipment Loan Agreement, in which case such agreement shall remain in effect in accordance with its terms. No waiver, termination, modification or amendment of any term will be effective unless in writing and signed by the party against whom it is asserted. If any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, such provision will be ineffective only to the extent of such invalidity or unenforceability, without invalidating the remaining provisions of this Agreement. This Agreement shall not be modified except by written agreement by the parties.

12. Miscellaneous

Language for all information and documents will be English unless otherwise agreed to in writing by Husky. Buyer agrees not to assign any of Buyer's rights or delegate any of Buyer's obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of Husky. Any protection granted by these terms and conditions will inure to the benefit of each of Husky's corporate affiliates.

STANDARD WARRANTY CONDITIONS (GLOBAL) ULTRA 250, 350, 500, 750, 1000, 1250, and 1750 HUSKY HOT RUNNER SYSTEMS and ALTANIUM HOT RUNNER TEMPERATURE CONTROLLERS

Parts Warranty

Husky Injection Molding Systems “Husky” warrants its Hot Runners, Altanium Hot Runner Temperature Controllers, hereinafter, “the Controller”, and Single Drops to be free of defects in design, material and workmanship under normal use and maintenance (as specified in the Husky Hot Runner Manual, Altanium Temperature Controller Manual or Husky Service and Safety Bulletins) for a period of up to 37 months, as set out in the Warranty Coverage Table attached as Appendix 1, starting on the date the Hot Runner and/or Controller are shipped ex works, hereinafter called the “Warranty Start Date”.

Leak-proof Warranty

Husky Hot Halves (Husky supplied plates) for Ultra 250, 350, 500, 750, 1000, 1250, and 1750 nozzles are guaranteed not to leak in the pocket area for a period of 37 months from the Warranty Start Date. In the event of such leak, Husky will provide the necessary parts and labor to return the hot half to its leak-free condition.

Replacement/Repair of Parts

- Husky reserves the right to repair or replace the Hot Runner and/or Controller, with new or refurbished parts at our discretion. Failed parts will be replaced with new or refurbished parts of equivalent quality. Repair or replacement of failed parts shall not extend the warranty coverage on the Hot Runner and/or Controller Equipment beyond the original expiration date.
- Husky will inform customers whether to return or dispose of defective parts that are under warranty. If Husky requires the return of failed parts, Husky will cover the costs of returning failed parts that are under warranty, as well as shipping and handling of replacement parts.
- Husky reserves the right to identify the method of shipment on all replacement parts supplied under warranty.
- Failure to return and properly identify requested warranty parts might result in the invoicing of such parts.

Limitations

This warranty shall not apply to:

- Labor costs
- Claims or damage resulting from customer or third party repairs or modifications to the Hot Runner and/or Controller, or other circumstances beyond Husky’s control.
- Claims or damage due to non-compliance with recommended installation, operation and maintenance procedures, as specified in the Husky Hot Runner and/or Controller Manual or Service and Safety Bulletins, including, without limitation, abuse, neglect, misuse of the Hot Runner by the customer, its agents or contractors
- Damage resulting from operation of systems at injection pressures greater than the following unless specifically designed and manufactured for higher-pressure applications in agreement with manufacturer:

- Claims or damage resulting from the use of third party parts. Husky recommends Husky Genuine Component parts for optimal system performance.
- Any direct or indirect loss, consequential loss, personal injury or damage to property, loss arising from interruptions or delays in production.
- Wear or damage resulting from corrosion or processing of abrasive/aggressive resins.
- Claims or damage resulting from non-standard parts or components specified by the original purchaser and supplied by Husky.

- Claims or damage resulting from auxiliary equipment and accessory parts, supplied but not manufactured by Husky, in which event we shall use reasonable efforts to pass on to the original purchaser the manufacturer's warranty. Examples include, but are not limited to: resin dryers, chilling equipment, air compressors, custom plasticizing screws, EOATool, perimeter guarding.
- Claims or damage resulting from purchaser's non-compliance with applicable laws, regulations, codes or by-laws, and standard industry practices.

Transfer of Warranty

Hot Runners and Controllers are only covered under the standard warranty to the original purchaser/molder of the tool and this warranty is non-transferable to, and may not be enforced by, any third parties, including, but not limited to, subsequent buyers, users or assignees of the Hot Runner.

Safety and Indemnity

The purchaser agrees to maintain and operate the Hot Runner and/or Controller safely and in accordance with Husky's recommended guidelines and applicable legal requirements.

The purchaser assumes all risks and liabilities for the operation and use of the Hot Runner and/or Controller. The purchaser agrees to defend and save Husky and its employees harmless from all claims and costs arising from any cause related to Hot Runner and/or Controller operation or use, except to the extent caused by Hot Runner and/or Controller defectively engineered or manufactured by Husky or serviced by Husky personnel, subject to the further limitation below.

Under no circumstances will Husky be responsible for claims or costs associated with product produced by the Hot Runner and/or Controller or for any consequential, special or incidental damages associated with its use.

Failure to comply with any safety requirements or conditions pertaining to injection molding machines can cause equipment damage, or serious personal injury, including death.
